To be considered, you or your firm must satisfy **all** of the requirements below.

1. **Current SBE or SBE+ certification from one of these three agencies only:**

- North Central Texas Regional Certification Agency (NCTRCA)
- Women's Business Council Southwest (WBCS)
- DFW Business Council (DFWBC)

Please be ready to provide your certification certificate, certifying agency, certification number, and expiration date. Note that some contracts specifically

require the SBE+ level (which adds a Personal Net Worth review on top of standard

SBE); tell us which level you hold.

2. **These certifications are NOT accepted for SBE credit: DBE, MBE, and WBE certificates do not qualify.**

(Firms holding both an SBE / SBE+ certification and a DBE/MBE/WBE certification are welcome — it is the SBE / SBE+ certification that qualifies your firm.)
